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FRACTION ACTIVITIES

- Comparing Fractions: Compare the sizes of different fraction strips to determine which fraction is larger or smaller.
- Equivalent Fractions: Find different fraction strips that are equivalent. For example, find the strip that is equivalent to $\frac{2}{4}$ by combining two half-strips.
- Adding and Subtracting Fractions: Combine or separate fraction strips to demonstrate addition and subtraction of fractions visually. For example, combine a half-strip with a third-strip to represent $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3}$.
- Fraction Recognition: Use the fraction strips to recognize and identify fractions. Hold up the fraction strip that corresponds to a fraction the teacher calls out.
- Fraction Ordering: Arrange the fraction strips in order from smallest to largest or vice
